The Roping Division features the best female ropers in the WPRA competing in team roping (header and heeler), tie-down roping and breakaway roping. World titles are awarded in each division as well as in the all-around category in which a competitor competes in more than one event winning more money than the rest of the field.

Sporting a small but loyal membership (that is currently growing in numbers and events), the women of the Roping Division have the opportunity to compete at events all over the United States in search of a world title.

Standings, based on money won at the

approved and co-approved events, are kept just like they are in the barrel racing division. At the end of the year, the WPRA hosts a World Finals featuring top competitors from each of the roping events that gives each competitor one last chance to win enough money to capture a world title.

This section features the 2019 World Champions as well as listings of past champions not only in the roping events but in the roughstock events of bareback riding and bull riding, when that was offered through the WPRA.

Crawford Captures her 19th world title in 2019

When she first started, Jackie Crawford set a goal to own the most world championships in WPRA history.

For the longest time, she admitted, it seemed like a pipe dream simply because Wanda Harper Bush had set the standard of 32 in the 1960s. So, Crawford decided upon climbing the ladder to see what was possible.

“I first set a goal to catch JJ (Hampton, 17), and that was the first thing that came,” said Crawford, who claimed her 19th world title in 2019 by earning the WPRA’s all-around crown with \$7,173, just \$1,086 ahead of the reserve champ, Kelsie Chace. “The more I got, the more I set the goal. Now that I have 19, I’m looking at that 32, and my goal is to keep setting new goals.

“This has me thinking of what the future might hold. The day I quit letting each world title set a new goal is probably the day I need to hang it up.”

Don’t look for that to happen anytime soon, and she proved why during her run at the WPRA Finals in October in Waco, Texas. The Stephenville, Texas, cowgirl pocketed \$4,752 that week, with the bulk coming in

team roping, where she placed five times in four rounds – she won the third round heeling for Chace and placed in all four as a header roping with Jessy Remsburg and won the average.

She also earned \$740 in breakaway roping, placing in one round and the average. It’s what pushed Crawford to hold off Chace in the process.

“It was a surprise because I know the competition there at the finals,” Crawford said Crawford. “It’s not just Kelsie, but I think of her because she does so many events so well. She’s one of the only ones who does tie-down as well, so knowing the money that was sitting on the table in tie-down, it felt a little stacked against me.”

For her part, Chace also made a run, pocketing \$4,363 in team roping, breakaway roping and tie-down roping. It just wasn’t enough to make the move on Crawford.

“This year I knew I had to go at it in the rounds, because I was down to one event,” Crawford said. “I didn’t get to tie-down, because I tore my meniscus right before the finals. I knew I had to get as much money in every round that I could and not just the

average. I ended up doing very well in the heading.

“Breakaway roping was tough this year. I drew a couple calves that were hard to place on, but I was still able to salvage some good money.”

Money is the game in rodeo. In the case of the WPRA’s all-around race, the lady with the most money earned at events featuring all roping events earns the crown. The key, as Crawford proved, is doing well at the finale in Waco. The key, though, is having the right

partnership between roper and equine.

“My main man, T-Boy, is almost 10 years now, and he’s been the key for me,” she said. “I’ve been using a young horse that’s 5 and have been hauling him, and I’ve been able to win some money on him. My team roping horses change in and out a little bit, but I have two or three of them that fluctuate.”

At the finals, she rode T-Boy for breakaway roping and Leroy in both heading and heeling. It came down to trust, and that’s something Crawford has found in both.

“The funny thing about Leroy is, we’ve got all these big-bred horses, and I use this gray freak of nature,” she said. “Leroy was the MVP. He did so good. That horse never faltered for me. He’s not a superstar, and he’s not fancy. He’s just willing, laid back and does what you ask of him. He just makes it easy.”

Most things horseback seems to come easy for Crawford, who won her first world championships in 2008 when she nabbed both the tie-down roping and all-around titles. She won the Triple Crown – three world championships in a season – in 2014 and ’16. It comes down to a couple of things that are the biggest strengths for her success.

“I think a lot of it is horsemanship, but I also think a little bit is the mental game with work ethic being right there,” Crawford said. “I’m just not going to go anywhere unprepared. I think it’s fun to see one of the best in the business, Kelsie Chace, living right at my house. We have a real competitive relationship. We’re on each other’s team, but I also get to sit and watch how hard Kelsie is doing something. I see that, and it pushes me to work harder so I can better her.

“I feel like I’ve always had that. It has almost been to a fault of putting too much time into it and toughing it out, but I know I’m going to be more prepared than anyone else.”

Jackie Crawford has 19 world championships to prove her method works, and she has several years ahead of her to keep adding to her trophy case.

THREE STRAIGHT

Chace Defends Her Breakaway Roping Title

In the biggest year in the history of breakaway roping, Kelsie Chace had the biggest season of all.

She finished the 2019 WPRA campaign with \$51,709 and outlasted another multiple titlist Lari Dee Guy for the world championship. She earned the title by pocketing nearly twice as much money this season as she did in winning the world title the year before.

“It was an awesome year,” said Chace, 29, of Freedom, Oklahoma, now living in Stephenville, Texas. “It was different this year because we had more and bigger opportunities. Part of The American counted, and we had a lot of bigger jackpots. I didn’t have the best (WPRA) Finals, but luckily I got to it.”

The championship in Waco, Texas, was a bit of a downer for Chace, particularly in breakaway roping where she roped two of four calves and placed in just one round. In fact, the 2.1-second finish in the second round earned her a share of second place with Guy, who also only cashed that one paycheck. That was enough for the Oklahoman to claim the crown.

“It was cool to win \$50,000,” Chace said. “Since part of The American counted, that was pretty big for me. I had a decent summer, then we went to Rapid City (South Dakota) in August, and that was a pretty big paycheck for me. Going into August, Lari Dee and Taylor (Munsell) were at the top, then I won \$6,700 there. That gave me a big boost.

“There was just a lot going on. It was cool to see all the opportunities we got. We got to see a lot of breakaway ropers this year.”

She beat them all to claim her seventh WPRA world championship.

“Every world title feels good,” she said.

“I was glad I got to take one home. I know I had a chance to take a couple more, but I knew it was going to take some work. Jackie (Crawford) placed in the average in breakaway roping and won the average (with Jessica Remsburg) in team roping (at the WPRA Finals) to win the all-around. She is the toughest roper we have right now.

“I was on top of breakaway roping most of the year, so I’m pretty excited about that.”

She should be, just as she should about finishing as the reserve all-around world champion, earning \$6,087 at events that featured all roping disciplines. She ended up \$1,086 behind Crawford for the title.

Chace knows a little more than most about Crawford, living on the same place as

the 19-time champion and her family. Both know the hard work and dedication it takes to come through the rigors of the season to claim world championships.

“In reality, it’s a full-time job,” Chace said. “I get to watch one of the best, if not the best, horsewomen every day. We get to pass ideas back and forth. I’ll study everybody. I’m always watching and trying to learn. I’m always trying to work on something for myself. I don’t want to practice just to practice; I want to get things done in the practice pen.

“I don’t want wasted loops or wasted runs.”

She didn’t waste many during the 2019 season, and she had several more chances than she’d had in previous years, thanks in large part to the explosion of breakaway

roping’s popularity. There were so many events that featured the sport, it took some planning to make sure she worked the right events in.

“To think about what everybody before us has done and put into it, and now seeing the work we’ve put into it, it’s so cool thinking about the young ones now coming up,” she said. “They’re not going to realize what it was like before. It’s nice to see a bigger future ahead.

“I think it’s great. The horse industry is getting better. I think everywhere we go where you have breakaway ropers, people are going to appreciate it. That’s more money to be spent in these little towns. It’s going to help members across the board.”

For many years, there weren’t many opportunities for ropers outside of intercollegiate rodeo. The WPRA has always had its roping categories, and that’s what makes the association special to the cowgirls that participate. Now, though, there are more eyes on the event Chace and so many other ladies love.

“For the fans, it’s easy to understand, and it’s super fast,” she said. “It’s another women’s event, and I think that’s really cool for people.”

For the competitors, each chance to compete is an opportunity for them to showcase their own talents as well as those of their horses.

“This summer, I bought a new horse to help out my roan horse that did so good,” Chace said of Roanie, a 14-year-old gelding. “He helped out at a couple of places, but most of it was done on the roan. We got a pretty good start at The American, then I just tried to stick with my game plan. I tried not to beat myself this year. I really worked on my horses and worked on my scoring.

“I’ve always been into the mental game, but I did a lot more this year.”

It showed.

DeSalvo Wins Third World Title, Robbins Ropes Her First

Although it wasn't a specific goal to become the WPRF World Champion Team Roping Header, Beverly Robbins followed up her third-place finish in 2017, and reserve championship in 2018, to earn the 2019 title. "I always want to win. I like to compete every time like I'm trying to win the world," the 56-year-old said. "It was something that just kind of happened. It wasn't really a goal, it just worked out during the year that I won some at the bigger ones to be ahead going into the finals."

Some of Robbins' biggest checks came from the all-girl ropings at Reno and The Patriot. "If you're lucky enough to win at those, it puts you in the driver's seat for the whole year to control the leaderboard," she said.

At the WPRF World Finals in Waco,

Texas, Robbins was roping with Rylie Smith from Whitsett, Texas. They placed in three rounds and finished second in the average to give Robbins \$27,698 in the WPRF Heading World Standings to finish ahead of Jackie

Crawford, who was roping with Robbins' usual heeler, Jessy Remsburg.

"She and Jackie started going to the WPRF Finals years before I did. Jessy works for me and we usually rope together. She and Jackie have done well, and I didn't want to bust them up, so I told them they had one more year," Robbins said with a laugh.

Robbins was riding a mare she calls Zena that she bought a couple years ago from fellow roper, Hope Thompson. "She's a really good match to my horse Snoop. He was injured so he didn't get to go so I had to take a backup horse. Hope has ridden her at the WPRF Finals so she knew the drill. She was good, and she was comfortable with the rope barrier so it worked out good," Robbins said noting that in the team roping they don't typically use rope barriers. "It was helpful to know she had already been there and done that."

While Robbins has always ridden horses, she didn't start roping until after college. "My dad was always into cows and horses, so as a kid I always had a horse because we were working cows and stuff. My dad roped a little bit and played a lot of polo. I really just played polo for a while," she explained. Robbins also played basketball and tennis in college. "I never picked up a rope until I got out of college. My dad was roping at that time, so I started roping the dummy for a year or so. When I finally roped my first steer, I got the bug really quick. My dad gave me his horses and we turned all of our polo horses into team roping horses. It was all I wanted to do from that point – I just wanted to rope."

Now that breakaway roping opportunities are on the rise, Robbins is planning to try that event. "I know that I really need to – it's crazy not to. It's something I've never done – I've never roped a calf," she said. "I'm going to start taking some lessons and learn how to do it right so I don't pick up any bad habits. I want some of these girls who have it all figured out to show me. It's tough, it's competitive. It's a lot of horse too so I have to find the horsepower – I have to find the horse

that will help me learn."

As an added benefit, Robbins thinks breakaway roping will help her in the heading to get her rope up faster and be more aggressive. "I'm really interested and curious and excited to put my time in breakaway for a little while and see what I can do." Then she added, "I wish team roping would've taken off as big as the breakaway has."

Robbins currently lives in Muscle Shoals, Alabama, but eventually plans to move to Texas. "I just bought me a place last year in Stephenville and got it kind of fixed up and ready to use. I go and stay a month or so at a time when I can, and fly back and forth. I love it – it's a fun getaway." Robbins stays extremely busy with a variety of things including developing lakefront property in Alabama, running a hotel, a Teflon coating business, running a ranch with about 1,000 head of mama cows, training and riding lots of horses, taking care of her mother who lives next door, owning a couple of health clubs, rental properties, remodeling a bunch of houses, and the list goes on. "It's busy, but fun. It's nothing that I don't enjoy. But I would like to slow down a bit. I have good help, so I'd like to turn some of it over," Robbins said. "I'm trying to get to the point where I can slow down a little bit, and mainly be a mother – I'm a single mother to a 14-year-old boy which is a full-time job in

itself,” she added with a laugh.

“I came home and went back to work,” Robbins said after winning the WPRC World Champion Team Roping Heading title. “I just did the best I could do throughout the year. I had fun with it and appreciated everything that came along with it. And it makes you want to try again, I’ll admit that. It makes you want to work harder to do it again.”

On the heeling side of the gold buckle, Whitney DeSalvo, from Springfield, Arkansas, knows exactly what it feels like to win the world championship again...and again. For the third consecutive year, she became the WPRC World Champion Team Roping Heeler. “It’s a marathon I feel like. You know, we go all year. Those ropings pay really good, and they’re tough. You’ve got to really show up to those big ones,” DeSalvo said. This year she won The Patriot with Jackie Crawford and she won The Spoke Invitational. She also placed at the Wildfire and Reno. “I was fortunate to start the year off good.”

But the end of August, DeSalvo broke her hand while heeling. “My dally popped off the top of my saddle horn and pulled my hand into the saddle horn. I had an external fixator on one of my fingers and had pins in my hand,” she explained. “I actually probably shouldn’t have, but I roped the dummy with those pins in,” she admitted with a laugh. “I just made sure I was still riding just in case I was released so I wouldn’t be totally unprepared.” She got the pins out about a week before the WPRC World Finals. “They told me they didn’t really want me to rope, but if I wasn’t going to hurt it and if I could keep it out of the way, that I could rope,” DeSalvo said about the doctor’s orders. Because of that, she decided to tie off while heeling at the WPRC World Finals. “I don’t ever tie off, ever – but I did so I could make sure I didn’t get it in a bind.”

DeSalvo only got to rope a couple days before heading to Waco, Texas where she

heeled for Hope Thompson. “They didn’t go how I had hoped, but I’m just grateful to be here,” DeSalvo said about the WPRC World Finals. They didn’t have the runs they wanted in rounds one and three, but they won the second round and placed second in the fourth round to finish sixth in the average. DeSalvo finished nearly 15 thousand dollars ahead of reserve champion, Annette Stahl after winning \$26,261 for the year. “I feel like every year – the past two or three years – I’ve gotten hurt at the end of the year and been released not long before the WPRC Finals. It never fails, I always get hurt,” she said with a laugh. “I’m glad that I had some luck throughout the year so it wasn’t a stressful weekend since I’m still a little hurt.”

Because of her hurt hand, heeling was the only event she competed in at the WPRC World Finals. “I figured one event at a time until it gets healed up all the way,” the two-time College National Finals breakaway roper said. Her passion for heeling actually came about after she had been a breakaway roper for “a long time.” She started heeling when she was 14 or 15 years old after attending a Britt Bockius clinic her friend in Arkansas hosted. “Then I played with it on and off until my sophomore year of college. I stopped roping calves for about two years and did nothing but heel. I fell in love with it I guess,” the student at University of Arkansas at Monticello said.

In addition to her own injury, the horse she usually heels on got hurt so she bought an 11-year-old little sorrel gelding named LJ earlier this year. “I hadn’t ridden him all year. I rode him at The Spoke back in August, and then I rode him here,” she said. “He’s really good – easy.”

When it comes to the future goals of the three-time WPRC World Champion Team Roping Heeler, she said, “I usually always sit down and write them down and I haven’t done that yet, but I hope to see how many more of these I can win.”

Talented teen Gambino claims WPRC world title

When the Women’s Professional Rodeo Association voted to allow junior contestants to compete in roping events in 2017, talented teens like Montana “Gracie” Gambino rejoiced. Fast-forward to now, and she’s a WPRC World Champion.

The 17-year-old from Lindale, Texas, lived up to her No. 1 back number at the WPRC World Finals Rodeo in Waco, Texas, Oct. 24-27, finishing third in the tie-down roping average to win the association’s 2019 tie-down roping world title. She and her beloved 7-year-old gray gelding, Gray Man, placed in three out of four rounds in the tie-down and finished the year with \$3,881, more than \$900 clear of reserve world champ Tanegai Zilverberg.

It was a nerve-racking four days for Gambino, who also qualified for the finals in 2017 and 2018, but she stuck to her plan and it paid off in a big way.

“It was definitely a big load on my shoulders,” she said of the world title pressure. “I knew I’d worked hard all year to get where I was, so I just needed to stay consistent and rope smart, and that’s what I did. You never know going into those kinds of things, because sometimes people have awesome finals and sometimes they have bad ones.”

“You can’t control the calves you draw and everything else, so I just knew I needed to go in there, do the best I could do, get all my calves roped and let the rest of it play out on its own.”

Gambino also entered the WPRC World Finals Rodeo ranked No. 1 in the all-around, but settled for a fifth-place finish in those standings despite finishing fifth in the team roping average with heeling partner Bailey Newsome. Regardless, 2019 was a dream season for the Texan, who will celebrate her

18th birthday on Dec. 12.

“I went in No. 1 in the all-around, but my main goal was the tie-down,” Gambino said. “Just going into the finals with that No. 1 back number is an amazing opportunity for a 17-year-old kid, so I’m just proud of myself for that.”

Gambino – a 2018 Junior NFR qualifier in barrel racing – has made the most of her WPRA opportunities since the association made the move to include juniors, and she couldn’t be happier with how things have progressed thus far.

“I’ve only had my card for about three years, but the first year I did it was the year they opened it up to junior contestants,” she said. “From there, I started just climbing the ranks, and I couldn’t have done that without the WPRA allowing younger women like myself to have that opportunity. It’s amazing.”

Gambino is home schooled and balances her studies with WPRA events, and she was able to execute her competition plan perfectly this season.

“We scheduled all of my other events around the WPRA events,” she said. “We definitely hit the road hard and tried to hit every event they had, and my goal really was to go into the finals No. 1 and come out No. 1, and that’s what I did.”

Gray Man was a big key to her success, along with her team roping horse, a 12-year-old mare named Clancy. Gambino has a special place in her heart for Gray Man.

“I use him for just about everything – barrels, poles, goats, breakaway and tie-down,” she said. “I can definitely say that is my heart horse. He gives me 110 percent every time, no matter what event we’re doing and I wouldn’t trade him for the world.”

Gambino also credits her family – mother, Hollie Gambino, father, Rodney Hayes, and younger brother, Cort – for their support along the way.

“It takes a village, and I definitely could not be where I am without them,” she said.

Gambino grew up on the back of a horse, even performing alongside her father in a rodeo specialty act called “Billy the Kid and The Pony Express.” It was great experience for the young cowgirl.

“As a kid, I was always riding horses and things like that,” she said. “We had some ponies and a bull and did an act. It was a total team effort, and kids from all over the country were in it.”

Gambino is determined and focused when it comes to her future and says that a WPRA world title won’t change her plans of pursuing a college degree while she continues to develop as a world-class competitor.

“I have some really good scholarship offers for college right now,” she said. “The main thing for me is I want to get a good education because, no matter where the rodeo road takes me, I want to have a good job or a backup plan in life. I’ll definitely go to as many WPRA events as possible, but it’s definitely a play-it-by-ear kind of thing.”

Gambino says qualifying for the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo is a career dream, but she’s going to pace herself and go with the flow for the time being. There’s no doubt her future is bright.

“I’ve always been one to have my mind set on what I want to do,” she said. “I don’t know exactly what I want to do, but I do know I want to work in the medical field. At this point, I’m just letting life kind of roll on, and we’ll just see where it goes.”
